

Important Notice Regarding EWS (Economically Weaker Section)

University has been established to commemorate the 550th birth anniversary of the first Sikh Guru - Guru Nanak Dev ji- and has also been named after Him. In the spirit of this holy and historic event, and in an attempt to living up to the social responsibility of educational institutions towards the economically weaker section (EWS) of society in general, the University offers a total of 550 seats in various courses free of cost to EWS category of students for its inaugural session (2021-22).

Of these, at least 1/3rd of seats (i.e. at least around 185) will be offered to girl students hailing from economically weak families.

The above seats will be offered on ‘first come first served’ basis to eligible EWS candidates irrespective of caste, creed, and religion, on production of their family income certificate (family annual income of less than Rs.2.50 lakh per annum issued by First Class Magistrate).
